### **The role includes:**

This role supports a small, well-managed site with 6 self-catering accommodation units, alongside shared facilities and grounds.

You'll be working alongside two permanent on-site wardens (a couple), with clear handovers and support in place; this is not a lone role.

- General site, grounds and accommodation maintenance
- Painting & decorating
- Landscape maintenance / gardening
- Basic plumbing, electrical or carpentry tasks
- Supporting accommodation changeovers
- Being a calm, visible and helpful on-site presence
- Working independently within a small, supportive team
- Occasional basic admin (computer literacy required)

Strong DIY or trade skills are a real advantage.

### **This role would suit someone who:**

- Is practical, reliable and self-motivated
- Enjoys hands-on work, variety and being outdoors
- Is physically capable of manual work
- Is calm and professional with guests

- Is happy working independently
- Is willing to undergo a DBS check (essential)

**Additional notes:**

- We are recruiting one person for the Seasonal Site Warden role
- If applying as part of a couple, there *may* be opportunities for the second person in cafe, housekeeping or watersports depending on experience, qualifications and availability (not guaranteed)
- Watersports access is limited and subject to staffing and safety cover
